According to National Pediculosis Association (NPA), "Seizures, behavioral changes, Attention Deficit Disorders, cancer, skin diseases, and even death have been reported to the National Pediculosis Association's registry by people who have used chemical treatments [such as RID and NIX] to get rid of head lice or scabies...Based on increasing reports of head lice resistance on a national level, the NPA advises parents to discontinue the use of head lice pesticides...MANUAL REMOVAL IS THE BEST OPTION".
